## Criteria of Eligibility

- To be citizens of Sri Lanka with the age of 40 or below as of April 1st of 2017
- To be Bachelor's degree holders
- Applicants to the University of Tokyo should have a Bachelor's degree in engineering, agriculture, or science
- Public-sector officers belonging to governmental organizations not semi-governmental organizations, and who have completed their probation period
- Applicants to Component 1, 2 and 3 should be a Staff Grade Officer (Non Staff Grade Officer will be eligible to apply to universities under Component 4)
- Officers of Central Bank of Sri Lanka will be eligible to apply to Hitotsubashi University
- Officers of National Building Research Organization will be eligible to apply to Land Slide Prevention Major under the University of Tokyo
- Having sufficient English language skills to undergo Higher Studies in English Medium

# What is JDS Programme?

Japanese Grant Aid for Human Resource Development Scholarship (JDS) Programme is 2-year-Master's Programme funded by the Government of Japan. Through the Programme, the Government of Japan awards 15 scholarships annually or 60 in total from 2014 to 2017 to Sri Lankan public sector officials. This will be a great opportunity for the officials to follow the Master's programme in the relevant field at any of the selected universities in Japan.

The objective of the JDS Programme is to contribute to the human resource development of Sri Lanka. The Programme targets highly capable and young public sector officers who are expected to play a leading role in formulating and implementing socio-economic development policies and plans of Sri Lanka in the near future.



## Fields of Study

In JDS Programme, target priority area is "Human Resource Development for Promotion of Economic Growth" and development issues for fields of study are called as 'Component'. Through the learning process up to receiving their Master's degree, JDS fellows from Sri Lanka are expected to acquire the knowledge and skills necessary for the development of Sri Lanka in an effective and efficient way.

## Benefits of JDS

- Round air tickets (between Sri Lanka & Japan) and other transportation fees
- Arrival allowance
- Shipping allowance
- Admission fee
- Tuition fee
- Monthly allowance for the rent and living cost in Japan
