## Drunkenness Smelling of Liquor or use Narcotics

Section 2 of Chapter XLVII of the Establishments Code amended by Public Administration Circular No. 308 dated 24.10.1985, is further amended as follows:

- being 2:1 Drunkenness, smelling of liquor, or under influence of narcotics whilst the on duty or through off duty in the premises of the office, will render officer liable for disciplinary an action.
- convicted offence under the 2:2 An officer of an influence of liquor or narcotics will be dismissed the first from service after conviction in а Count or Law.
- 2:3 In a Departmental Inquiry in to the offence of drunkenness smelling liquor, or of or the evidence of two senior officers of Staff Rank will be sufficient to establish an officer's guilt; and officer so found guilty will be dismissed.

Medical obtained А Report should be from a Government Medical Officer Judicial or a Medical Officer to established the guilt of officer suspected having taken an of narcotics. officer An SO found guilty will be dismissed from service.

2. The provisions of this circular will be applicable to employees of Public Corporations too.
