Public Officers affected by terrorist and

Subversive activities

The government has decided that the affected Public Officers, Corporation Employees and Local Government employees due to terrorist/subversive activities are entitled to the following benefits in addition to relief's they are entitled to in terms of previous Public Administration Circulars irrespective of their monthly income.

(i) Rs. 2,000.00 (two thousand) in cash for funeral expenses in case of a death.

(ii) Those displaced officers who are living temporarily with friends/relations or at welfare centers are entitled to dry rations from a nearby Co-operative store from the date of such displacement. This will continue until 6 months after they are re-settled at their own residences. The following chart indicates the value of the dry ration per week according to the number of persons in the family.
