Incentives, Increments and Promotions for Public Officers Proficient in more than one Language

- (v) An officer who has been paid Rs. 500/in terms of 379 Treasury Circular No. is entitled to not get incentives Sinhala G.C.E. for language up to ((0/L))since is he bound to work in Sinhala medium up to that level.
- (vi) All these payments should be done subject to section 6 of the above circular.

When special nonpensionable increments are paid to officers in terms of this scheme, they should be not placed salary on the next higher steps in the scale, but be paid allowance equal to the increment.
