## Public Officers Retired In Terms of Public Administration Circular No. 44/90 to Contest at Elections

Public Officers retired in terms of Public Administration Circular No. 44/90 of 18.10.1990 in order to contest at the Parliamentary General Elections 1994 may be reinstated, provided that they:-

- a) are in the category of Public Officers not entitled to exercise Political Rights interms of Chapter XXXII of the Establishments Code;
- (b) were not elected due to their not obtaining a sufficient number of Preferential Votes:
- c). have made a request for re-employment; and
- d). are under the optional age of retirement.
- 02. The period between their retirement and the re-instatement has to be set off against their accumulated leave and if there is a balance period of absence it should be treated as no-pay leave.
- 03. They should submit substantial proof to the effect that they have actually retired in terms of Public Administration Circular No. 44/90 to contest at the elections and did contest.
- 04. Provisions of this Circular may be applied to the contestants of the Local Authority Elections 1991 and Provincial Councils Elections 1993 and 1994.
