REPORT OF THE SALARY REVISION AND ANOMALIES COMMITTEE
OF 09.09.1994 INTERIM ALLOWANCE

Your reference is drawn to Public Administration Circular No. 33/94 of 12.08.1994.

02. The Government has made the following decisions in respect of the interim allowance granted only to a few services by the Public Administration Circular No. 33/94 of 12.08.1994. This allowance is not counted for pension purposes.

- (I) To continue the payment of the interim allowance to services such as Engineering , Veterinary, Agricultural, until a salary revision is made by the Salaries and Cadres Committee.
- (II) To pay that interim allowance on the same basis to the officers of the following services with effect from 1st July 1994.
 - a) Secretaries and Additional Secretaries of Cabinet Ministries - Rs. 2,000/- per month.
 - b) Sri Lanka Administrative Service
 - c) Sri Lanka Educational Administrative Service
 - d) Sri Lanka Accountants' Service
 - e) Sri Lanka Planning Service
 - f) Medical Service (Specialists and non-Specialists)
 - g) Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service
 - h) Other parallel Managerial Services which will be identified by the Salaries and Cadres Committee on case by case basis.

03. Interim Allowance will be paid as follows to the services mentioned from (b) to (g) above.

Class II Grade II	-	Rs. 1,600/- per month
Class II Grade I	-	Rs. 1,750/- per month
Class I	-	Rs. 2,000/- per month

04. The Salaries and Cadres Committee will decide the method of payment to the services mentioned in (h) above.

05. This interim allowance can be paid to the re-employed pensioners who have served in the posts of the above mentioned service and re-employed in the same posts, until they hold those posts.

06. Please take action accordingly.
