**List of Names of Disciplinary Inquiry Officers issued
under Section 19:5 Chapter XLVIII Part II of
the Establishments Code**

In terms of Section 19:5 Chapter XLVIII, Part II of the Establishments Code which was brought into operation with effect from 01/11/1999 under the title “Disciplinary Control of Public Officers - Part II of the Establishments Code” by Public Administration Circular No.23/99 dated 29/10/1999, the Secretary of the Ministry in Charge of the subject of Public Administration is required to maintain a Pool of Disciplinary Inquiry Officers.

02. Until the list of names attached to such Pool is issued, Staff Officers with ten years service or more selected out of the officers whose names appear in the Public Administration Circulars mentioned below should continue to be employed to perform the functions set out in Section 19:6 Chapter XLVIII, Part II of the Establishments Code.
