## LEAVE PRIVILEGES TO PUBLIC OFFICERS RELEASED FOR SERVICE IN STATE-SPONSORED CORPORATIONS/BOARDS

PUBLIC officers of any grade released for service in State-Sponsored Corporations/Boards are not eligible to the leave privileges in terms of the F.R.R. applicable to public Officers, while they are in the service of such Corporations/Boards. They will have to earn leave during such periods according to the leave regulations of such Corporations/Boards, and will have no claim during such periods for any leave earned before their employment in such Corporations/Boards. Similarly, on their reversion to the Public Service, they will have no claims for any leave earned while in the service of the Corporations/Boards. Any leave earned and not availed of during the period of their service in such Corporations/Boards will be treated as having lapsed, and what will remain to their credit would only be the leave earned by them during service under Government before joining the Corporations/Boards.

The contents of this Circular should be brought to the notice of all public officers now on release for service in Corporations/Boards. Similarly, this should be made clear at the time of release to all such officers.

Permanent Secretaries are requested to bring to the notice of all Corporations/Boards under their Ministries the contents of this Circular.
