POLITICAL RIGHTS FOR PUBLIC SERVANTS

Amendment to Administrative Regulation 261

The new Administrative Regulation 261 contained in Public Administration Circular No. 14 is hereby amended to read as follows :—

“261. All Public Servants, except the following categories, will be entitled to full political rights as defined in Administrative Regulation 262 :—

- (i) Members of the Judiciary;
- (ii) Members of the Armed Services;
- (iii) Members of the Police Force and other Peace Officers exercising Police functions under the Criminal Procedure Code (e.g., Grama Sevakas);
- (iv) Prison Officers as defined in Section 20 of the Trade Unions Act (Chapter 138) and
- (v) All Staff Officers or Supervisory Officers in the Public Service. A “Staff” or “Supervisory” Officer will be defined for this purpose as a public servant, the initial of whose salary scale is Rs. 6,720 per annum or over (Consolidated)”.
