Efficiency Bar Examination of officers of Class III of Public Management Assistants' Service

Public Service Commission has decided to grant the officers who have been recruited to Class III of Public Management Assistants Service on 01.07.2007, 02.02.2009 and 02.04.2009 on the results of the Limited Competitive Examination for promotion of Junior Employees of Public Service to Class III of Public Management Assistants Service, a concessionary period in the following manner for appearing for the efficiency bar examination held consecutively at four occasions from the date of appointment, for them to pass the same, as a result of not conducting the efficiency bar examination which had to be conducted in relation to Class III of Public Management Assistants Service.
