Promotion to Special Class of Librarians' Service as per Minute of Sri Lanka Librarians' Service published in the Gazette Extra Ordinary No: 1620/22 dated 24.09.2009

Applications are called from the Librarians of Sri Lanka Government Librarians' Service, who satisfy the qualifications of Class I of Sri Lanka Government Librarians' Service in the following manner in order to be promoted to Special Class of the Librarians' Service as per the provisions in paragraph 6:3:4 of the Minute of Sri Lanka Government Librarians' Service published in the Gazette Extra Ordinary No: 1620/22 dated 24.09.2009.

- 02. Qualifications to be promoted to Special Class
- (A) i Shall have completed at least a satisfactory and active service period of 05 years in a post of Librarian in Class I.

and

Shall have completed a one year Post Graduate Diploma in Library and information Science from a recognized university.

or

ii Shall have completed at least a satisfactory and active service period of 03 years in a post of Librarian in Class I.

and

Shall have completed a two-year Post Graduate Degree on research in Library and information Science and Information Science from a recognized university.

(B) Shall have completed a computer course on Library Science (duration not less than 160 hours) conducted by a university/recognized government institution or the Sri Lanka Library Association.

and

- (C) Shall have obtained Chartered Librarianship.
- 03. Promotion to Special Class is made by the Public Service Commission on the number of existing vacancies and as per the order of merit at the interview of assessing the eligibility to allocate marks for seniority and merit conducted by a Board of Interview appointed by the Public Service Commission, after getting the qualifications verified by the Appointing Authority.

The marking scheme, which is made applicable at the said interview, is attached as Annex 01.

04. Qualifications are verified as at 08.08.2016 and in case the officers, who have been sent on retirement, were engaged in service as at the date on which the following posts have fallen vacant and satisfied all the required qualifications, they can apply for this. The dates on which the posts in Special Class of the Librarian Service have fallen vacant from 02.09.2012 to 08.08.2016 are indicated below.

Accordingly, a certain retired officer applying for this should satisfy all the qualifications and should be engaged in active service as at the date on which the post falls vacant to be eligible for promotion to Special Grade due to the existing vacancy. Thus, the vacancies are filled based on the seniority and merit of the officers.

- 05. Both conditions of satisfying the qualifications and existing of vacancies should be fulfilled for this promotion to be implemented.
- 06. All the officers in the Ministries and Departments including other public institutions belonging to Sri Lanka Librarian Service, who become eligible to be promoted, should submit the

applications, which are prepared as per the specimen format attached herewith, to the Heads of Departments. The Heads of Departments should certify to the effect that the particulars indicated in the applications are accurate and send them to the Director General of Combined Services along with the birth certificate of the applicant, letter of appointment, letter of confirmation, letters of promotion, certified copies of the educational certificates and other certificates to prove the qualifications with the recommendations of the Secretary of the Ministry.
