7.2.5 Method of Recruitment:

A number of applicants out of those who have passed the written examination as determined by the Appointing Authority based on the order of merit of the marks obtained by them at the written examination and the number of existing vacancies will be called for the General Interview. The General Interview will be conducted only to examine the basic qualifications and the applicants who have fulfilled the qualifications will be recruited upon the results of the written examination.



7.3.3 Other

- (II) Shall have completed at least 05 years of an active and satisfactory period of service in a permanent departmental post in public service as at the prescribed date and shall have certified the same by the Head of the Department.
- (IV) Shall not have been subject to a disciplinary punishment as per the provisions in Public Service Commission Circular No. 01/2020.
